

With the start of our new fiscal year on July 1, we have some news to share. Linda Mingos has become the Coordinator of Religious Education, Pat Clement has become the Coordinator of Adult Christian Formation, and Chris Lothamer has become full-time Music Coordinator. Congratulations to all!

Thank you all again for your continued generosity and financial support of our parish. It is only through your support that we can continue our ministries and service to our community. Please see in the insert our budget acknowledgement letter and chart. Based on our income during the pandemic thus far, we projected about a 7.5% decrease in collections this year. We have striven to keep our expenses manageable (I and all the active priests in the diocese voluntarily took a 10% pay decrease for the last three months of this past fiscal year), and please know that we strive to be good stewards of our resources, especially through the finance council's monthly meetings.

I myself have enrolled in monthly giving through the site (as well as to our second collections), and I have increased my donations. If you have been blessed with financial security during the pandemic, please do consider increasing your donations. 

Budgeted Expenses - Fiscal Year 2020-2021

Special Notes about Budgeted Expenses for FY 2020-2021

- Current budgeted expenses represent an overall increase by less than 1%.
- Diocesan budgeted expenses (includes Cathedraticum Assessment and Diocesan School Assessment) up by less than 1%. In addition, The Diocesan School Assessment will be reduced by an additional 10% for the months of July 2020 thru September 2020.
- 38% of the Salaries/Benefits are directly in support of our ministries.
- Budget does not include LOM (Living Our Mission) spending on our capital projects. These are tracked separately and funded through your LOM (Living Our Mission) giving.
- In accordance with Diocesan directives, the administration team and Finance Council monitor the actual expenses against the budget monthly.

PARISH LIFE

Haga Fund – During these uncertain times, parishioners who find themselves in financial need can turn to the Haga Fund for assistance. The Fund was started in 2010 with a bequest from the estate of Elisa Haga, a long-time parishioner at St. Ann. With her generosity, the parish was able to endow a fund that fulfills her desire to help those in need. It is administered by the pastor, the pastoral associate, and three parishioners named by the pastor, and all proceedings are held in confidence. Prayer Lists – One of the ways we care for one another is through our prayers for those who are sick or suffering. At St. Ann, we have two prayer lists. The prayers for those who are ill that we hear on Sunday are for those who are in a health crisis: hospitalized, anticipating or recovering from major surgery, or facing death. In the bulletin, we list those who are in long-term situations of illness or recovery. For the Sunday prayers, we are instituting a limit of 4 weeks for a person's name to be listed; in the bulletin, the limit will be 3 months. In either case, the time can be lengthened if arranged. A Note from AARP TaxAide

“The AARP TaxAide site at St. Ann's Catholic Church completed 256 returns in 2020 before the site was closed on March 16, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The site will not re-open this tax season due to lingering concerns about the health and safety of the TaxAide volunteers and their clients.

TaxAide is grateful to Fr. Danny and the staff at St. Ann's for making their facilities available to support tax preparation for elderly and low income individuals in our community.

Alternatively, AARP Foundation is offering on-line options to assist taxpayers through the AARP TaxAide website, in lieu of in-person tax assistance. A self-preparation option with access to free software is available, as well as a link to request assistance from a volunteer to help complete their taxes.
